## Being a bartender is not a crime... 30-second commercial script

*(SFX of bartender / pub / bar noise in background – voiceover begins 2 second into SFX)*

Ron: **Non-smoking bartenders, in every eight-hour shift, inhale as much smoke as they would if they smoked 36. They have higher rates of lung cancer than fire fighters. Current Kingston by-laws restrict smoking in workplaces. Restaurants, bars, bingo and pool halls aren't completely smoke-free.**
